Research

During my time as a Research Fellow at Harris Birthright Research Centre for Fetal Medicine, I have been the leading person on a study involving examination of ultrasonographic markers for the screening of Down's syndrome, in particular of the examination of the fetal profile for assessment of the absence/presence of the fetal nasal bone.

Furthermore, I have been actively involved in coordinating multi-centre randomized trials, based at General district Hospitals and at King's College Hospital, on the screening of preterm delivery by vaginal sonographic assessment of the cervical length at 23 weeks' gestation, and of pre-eclampsia by Doppler study of the uterine arteries both in the first and second trimesters of pregnancy.
